### FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION FOR 2003 SUMMER SCHOOL AND SUMMER FEDERAL WORK-STUDY

The Office of Student Financial Services offers the following programs to assist in financing summer school:  
**Georgetown Scholarship**  **Federal Subsidized or Unsubsidized Stafford Loan**  **Federal Perkins Loan**  
 **Federal Work-Study**  **Federal PLUS Loan**  **Federal Pell Grant**  **Private Loan**

**STUDENTS WHO WILL ENROLL IN SUMMER SCHOOL:** If you are enrolled in a degree or eligible certificate program at Georgetown and will be registered for at least three credits (summer half-time equivalent) you may be eligible for financial aid.

**STUDENTS WHO WILL NOT ENROLL IN SUMMER SCHOOL:** If you are a degree candidate at Georgetown and do not plan to take Summer School classes, you may apply for full-time Federal Work-Study **only**; eligibility is determined based on your 2003-2004 FAFSA and you must be returning to Georgetown as a degree candidate in the Fall of 2003.

**Scholarship Application Deadline:** Priority will be given to students who complete their applications for financial aid by April 30, 2003

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Undergraduate students applying for Georgetown Scholarship must have filed both the 2002-2003 CSS Profile form and the 2002-2003 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and must complete the Georgetown summer aid application on the back of this form. Only undergraduate students who received Georgetown Scholarship during the 2002-2003 academic year will be considered for Georgetown Scholarship to attend the Summer School. *Priority will be given to those who need the scholarship in order to graduate with their class.* In addition, all undergraduate Georgetown Scholarship applicants **must** receive the approval of their school Dean **before** being considered for Georgetown Scholarship. The Dean must sign the aid application on the reverse side of this form.

Graduate students and Liberal Studies students (both graduate and undergraduate) must file a 2002-2003 FAFSA and the Georgetown summer aid application to be considered for Georgetown Scholarship. Graduate students must get approval from their academic department.

**Federal Stafford Loan, Federal Perkins Loan, Federal Work-Study and/or Federal Pell Grant applicants** who have not already done so must file the **2002-2003 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** with the federal processor by June 30, 2003. All applicants must complete the summer 2003 aid application on the reverse side of these instructions. Application materials must be received prior to the start of the session in which you intend to enroll. A **2002-2003 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** is not required if you are **only** applying for a Federal PLUS Loan or private loan but you must complete the summer application on the reverse side of this form for us to determine your eligibility.

**Loan Entrance Counseling:** Federal regulations require first time Federal Stafford Loan borrowers and all Federal Perkins Loan borrowers to complete Entrance Counseling before disbursement can occur. Loan Entrance Counseling for the Federal Stafford Loan may be completed online at our web site <http://finaid.georgetown.edu/stencoun.htm>. Students awarded a Federal Perkins Loan may check the Entrance Counseling schedule at <http://finaid.georgetown.edu/loanentr.htm>. Students studying away should attempt to complete Entrance Counseling prior to departure.

**Loan Disbursement Notes:** To receive your loan disbursement you must be pre-registered or enrolled for all summer courses on which loan eligibility was based. The net proceeds of the loan will be delivered in one disbursement. Federal loan proceeds received by electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) will be disbursed to your student account no earlier than five days before the start of classes. Private loan proceeds will be disbursed to your student account no earlier than ten days before the start of classes. Loan proceeds received by check will require your endorsement at the Office of Student Accounts. Please plan your financing accordingly.
